Here are some of the subject areas we will be covering between now and Easter.

#### English:

Reading for information, using evidence from texts, researching and writing a biography, writing for a specific audience and planning, editing and evaluating texts.

**Maths:** Written and mental addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, properties of of shapes including equilateral, isosceles, scalene and right-angled triangles, finding unit fractions and non-unit fractions of 3-digit numbers, identifying prime numbers; revising finding factors of numbers; finding squares and square roots of square numbers and converting units of of measurement.



Science: Forces/Space

History: The life of Neil Armstrong and the 1960s

Geography: Day and night, seasons and time zones

**RE**: What makes a person inspiring to believers?

PE: Hockey, gymnastics and swimming

**Computing:** Cryptography and creating a virtual space

Art: Landscape drawing, painting and pastels

Music: Composing and Holst's 'The Planet Suite'
