#### **EYFS**

At the end of Reception, pupils are assessed against the EYFS assessment framework. Children are assessed at having a Good Level of Development (GLD) if they meet the criteria in all areas.

### **Year 1 Phonics Screening**

At the end of Y1, pupils are assessed in their phonic knowledge. This is not a comprehension test and does not assess understanding. Rather, it tests pupils' ability to sound out words and pseudo-words correctly using their phonological skills.

#### **Key Stage 1**

At the end of Year 2, the national expectation is that pupils reach the 'expected standard' (EXS) with no gaps in attainment or knowledge. Those who have attained well are working at 'greater depth' within the expected standard (GD).

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# **Key Stage 2**

At the end of Year 6, the national expectation reach the 'expected standard' (EXS) with no gaps in attainment or knowledge. Those who have attained well are working at 'greater depth' within the expected standard (GD). There is no test for writing in KS2 - the results are by teacher assessment (TA).
