I hope you have all had lovely half term break.


Our key question for this term is:

We will also be promoting Speaking and Listening skills, new vocabulary and introducing phonic sounds for Reading. Our learning is based around quality texts in all areas.

In Literacy we will be celebrating World Nursery Rhyme Week, plus using 'The Gingerbread Man' as our key text for writing. We will also be reading lots of Traditional Tales and learning the key features of a Traditional Tale, such as key phrases 'once upon a time' and 'happily ever after.'

kit on Mondays: coloured t-shirt, shorts.

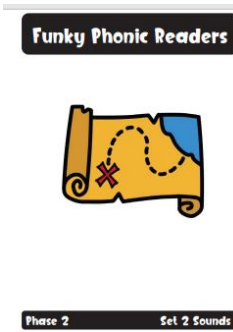
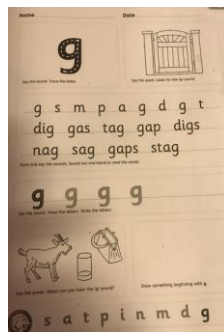
If it is cold, please wear joggers.
