

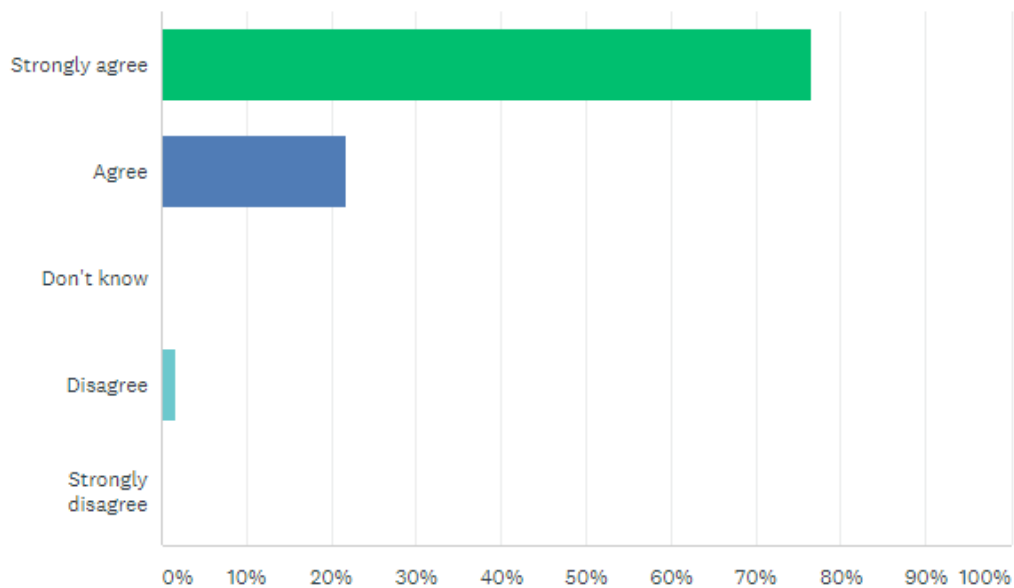

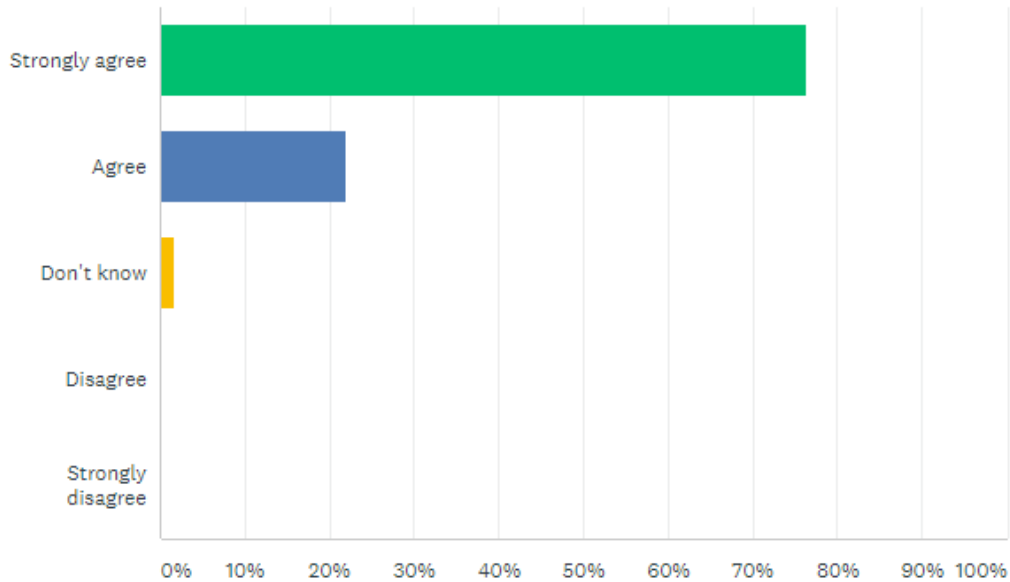

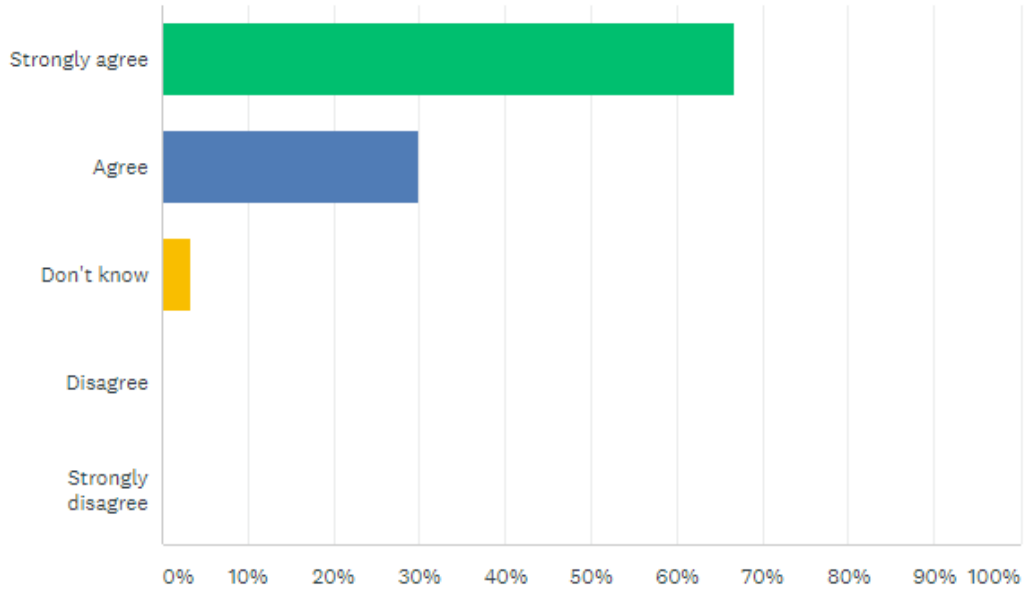

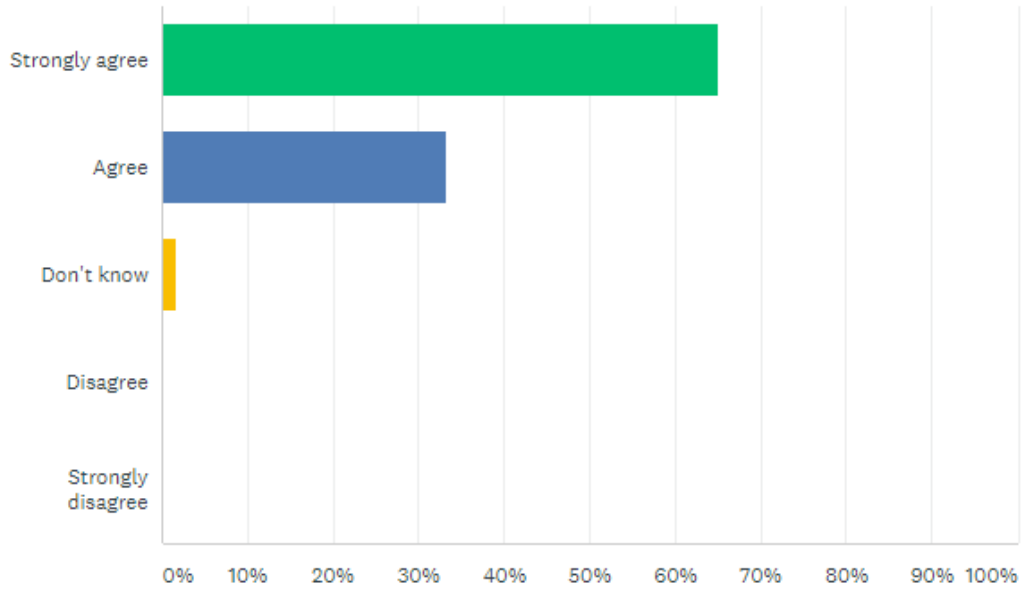

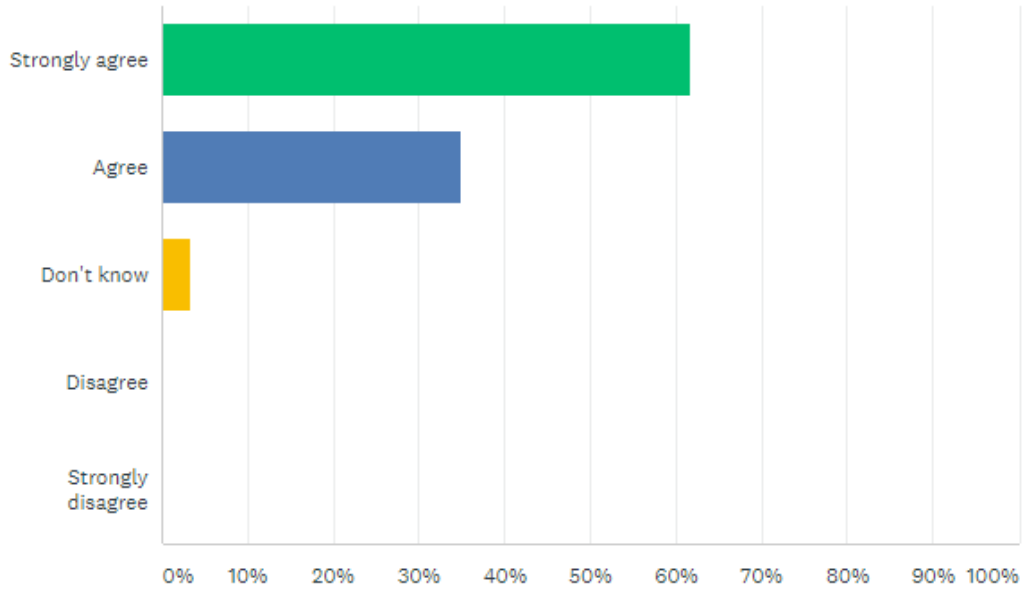

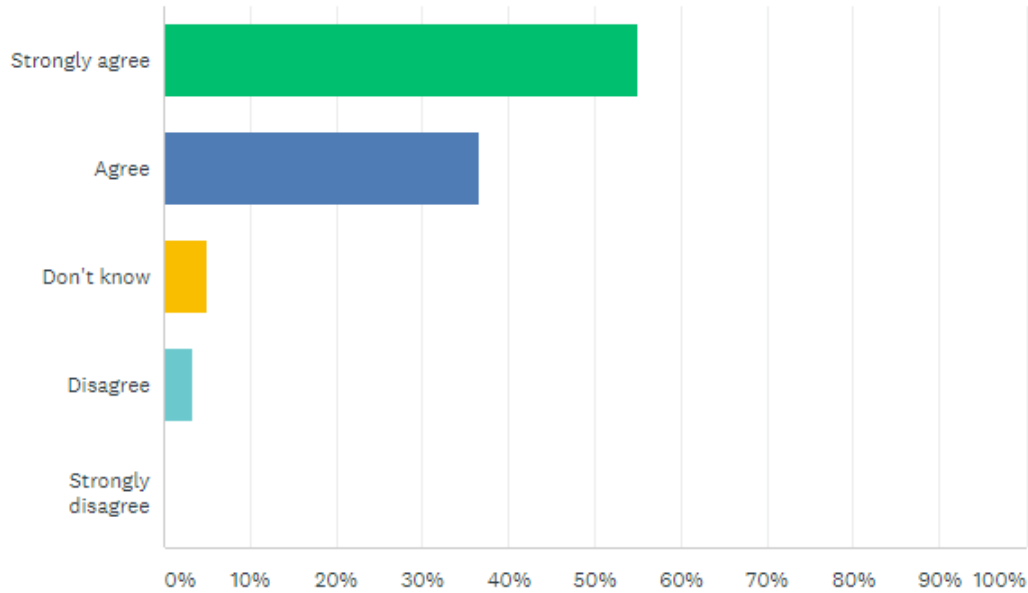

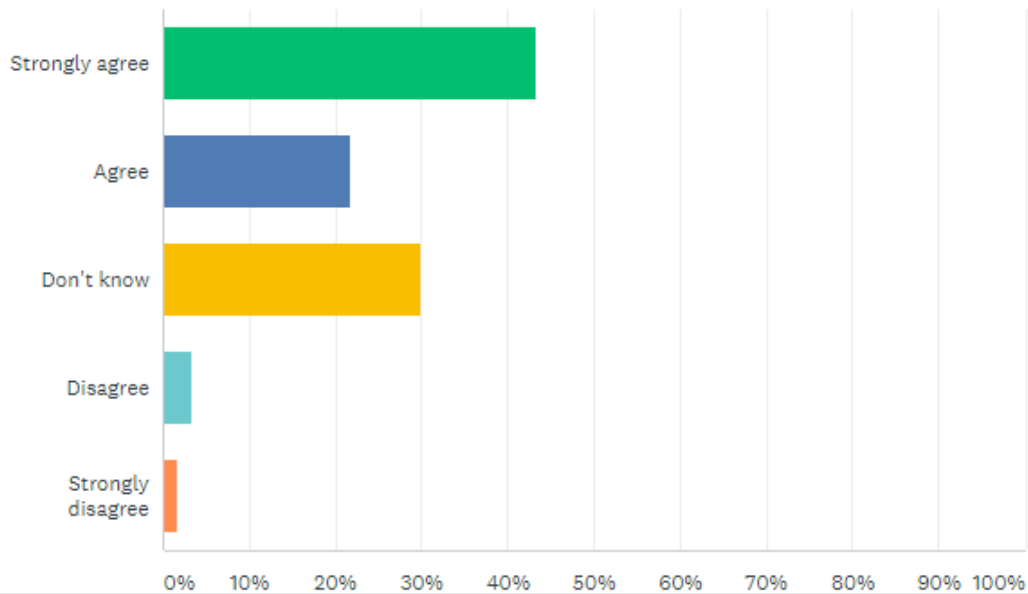

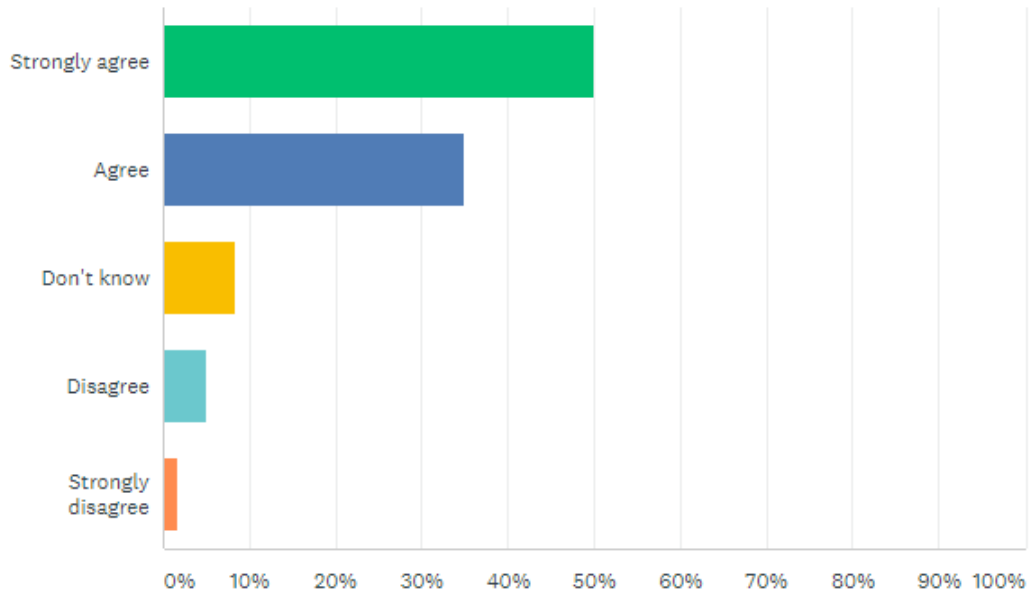

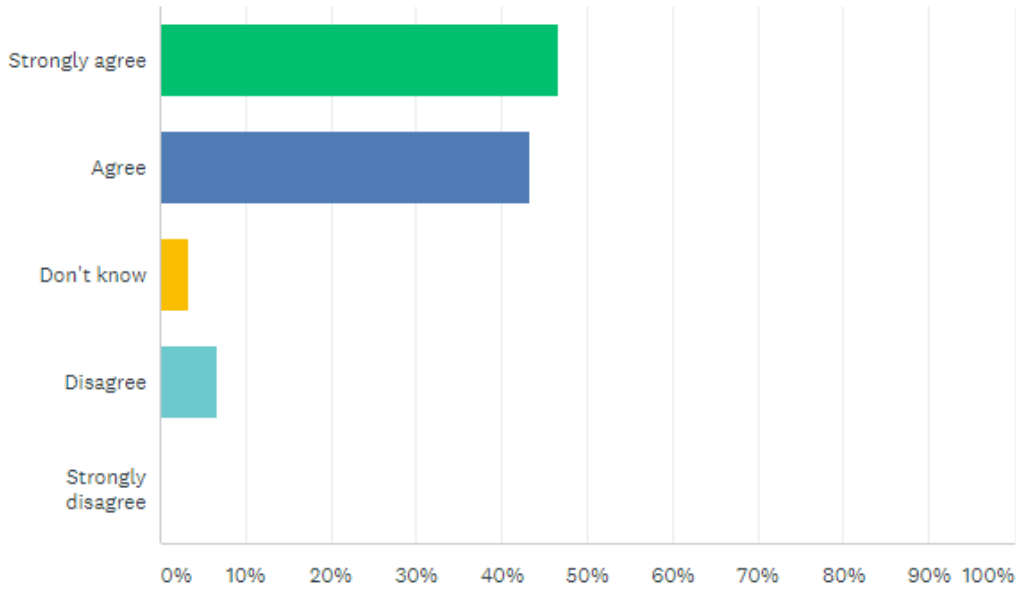

We like the school, but feedback about children only seems to happen during a parents' consultation or report. Any issues, or advice with work doesn't seem to be mentioned. Where we have answered don't know that's because our children don't say or we believe progress is being made by what we see at home with homework but we are unsure if it applies to in class. As for being taught well, we believe that all teachers are good but we can't comment as the progress isn't shared until parents' eve etc we mentioned before. St John's is a lovely school but something is missing with communicating with parents/careers.

Generally very pleased with the school although it just sometimes feels like school knows best and that is that! A bit too pushy with use of technology - there is more to life. Does seem to be more stress to rush through things than to make sure basics are solidly learnt.

My son has only been in school for a few months and I don't know how his learning compares. However we think the school is excellent and are very happy with the teachers and grateful for all the help and support he is receiving. It would be useful to understand the school's position on the SATs results. The press reporting was pretty negative but I'm sure this isn't the complete story
