


Big Question: Which animals hatch out of an egg?

Know some similarities and differences between things in the past and now, drawing on their experiences and what has been read in class. Understand the past through settings, characters and events encountered in books read in class and storytelling. <p>People, Culture and Communities</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Describe their immediate environment using knowledge from observations, discussions, stories, non-fiction texts and maps. Know some similarities and differences between families, different religious and cultural communities, cultures and traditions. 	<p>Changes within living memory</p> <p>Changes from a baby, to a toddler to a school child and beyond.</p> <p>Events beyond living memory</p> <p>Refer back to dinosaur topic in term 3.</p>	<p>Changes within living memory</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I know how I have changed <p>Significant historical events, people and places in their own locality</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Thinking about changes in our life as we grow and get older comparing to the life cycle of animals. <p>Refer back to Term 3 - dinosaurs and Mary Anning.</p> <p>General learning throughout the year:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Through interactions talking about what they did yesterday, last week, last year. Personal history; how they celebrate Christmas, new year, family celebrations such as Birthday's - throughout the year. Learning about the family traditions of children in class from different cultural backgrounds.

I know that as I get older I can do different things. I know that my Grandparents are my Mum and Dads parents. I know that things have changed since my Mum and Dad were little. I know which objects are from the past and which are modern. (toys / home artefacts) I know some facts about people from the past - Guy Fawkes, Florence Nightingale, Neil Armstrong, Mary Anning. I know that some stories have been around for a long time and that some are new. I know that families celebrate in different ways. I know some celebrations / festivals and can say why they are celebrated (Christmas, Easter, Bonfire Night, Diwali, Chinese New Year).
