<b>Chronological Understanding</b>	Sequence some events in my life chronological order Use common words and phrases relating to the passing of time e.g. old, new, young, days, months, today, yesterday, tomorrow Recount parts of stories and memories about the past Know some things that happened to other family members in the past.	Discuss how I have changed throughout my own life time. Order key events in my own life time. Sort pictures from the past and present. Know what a timeline is and answer questions using one. Understand what a monarch is and where monarchs live. Compare our lives to those of the monarchy.	Identify history as events which have happened in the past and order events in our lives. (Baby photo to current photo.) Can include christening, birth of siblings, first holiday, first day at school etc.  Identify what a family tree is and what it shows before constructing a family tree to show close family.  Create a timeline of own key events 0-6yrs and answer questions.  Compare similarities and differences between our childhoods and that of our grandparents.  Explore the life of Queen Elizabeth II.  Create a family tree of the monarchy starting with Queen Elizabeth II.

<b>Historical interpretation</b>	Begin to identify and recount some details from the past from sources eg. pictures, stories, artefacts.
