

Big Question: How have seaside holidays changed over the years?

<b>Chronological Understanding</b>	<p>Know some things that happened to me in the past.</p> <p>Talk about past and present events in their own lives and in lives of family members and know the difference.</p> <p>Use every day language related to time e.g. old, new, young, days, today, yesterday, tomorrow</p> <p>Order and sequence familiar events in their own life</p> <p>Put toys of different ages in chronological order</p>	<p>Identify features of a seaside holiday.</p> <p>Use photographs to find clues as to what seaside holidays were like in the past.</p> <p>Discuss when and how seaside holidays became popular.</p>	<p>Children will think about different holidays they have during the year. They will explore the features of seaside holidays using photographs as a prompt. They will identify key vocabulary associated with the seaside and discuss activities that people might do during a seaside holiday.</p> <p>Children will use photographs and paintings to look for clues about what seaside holidays were like in the past. They will use these clues to start understanding how seaside holidays were different to how they are today. They will also start to order photographs chronologically.</p> <p>Children will find out why seaside holidays were initially only enjoyed by the rich and why this changed during the Victorian era, looking particularly at the role of the steam train in allowing people to visit the beach.</p> <p>Children will use photos to help them identify what seaside holidays were like during the Victorian and Edwardian periods. They will discover some of the features of traditional seaside holidays, such as Punch and Judy shows, and start to think about how these holidays are similar to or different from our seaside holidays today.</p> <p>Children will identify ways in which seaside holidays have changed through the ages. They will order photographs of different aspects of seaside holidays chronologically and identify similarities and differences between them.</p> <p>Children will explore some of the ways in which seaside holidays in the Victorian and Edwardian periods were both similar to and different from seaside holidays today. They will consider aspects such as travel to identify ways in which life has changed in the last hundred years.</p>
<b>Knowledge and understanding of past events, people and changes in the past</b>	<p>Find out facts about seaside holidays from long ago. (Before living memory.) and compare them to their own holidays using a variety of sources.</p>	<p>Discuss what seaside holidays were like 100 years ago.</p> <p>Order seaside holidays in chronological order.</p> <p>Identify similarities and differences between seaside holidays now and in the past.</p>	
<b>Historical interpretation</b>	<p>Use a variety of sources including books, photographs, artefacts and the internet to help me find out about the past and answer simple questions.</p> <p>Listen to stories about the past.</p>		
<b>Historical Enquiry</b>	<p>Look at pictures and discuss, "How do the seaside holidays look different?"</p> <p>Answer questions about events, using 'before' and 'after' to describe when something happened.</p> <p>Look at clothes worn at the beach from the past and discuss, "How are they different to what we wear today?" and try to answer.</p> <p>Look at photos of seaside holidays from the past and discuss, "How have they changed over time?
