Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back! We hope you have had a relaxing half term break.

Our question for this term is: What are the physical and human features of Gloucestershire?

In this geography topic, we will embark on a fascinating journey of discovery by locating Gloucestershire on UK map and identifying some of its main features through exploring a variety of images and online mapping. We will also learn about different forests in Gloucestershire and focus on the physical and human features of Forest of Dean. We will conclude the topic by discovering how Forest of Dean has changed over time due to deforestation and the impact this has had on tourism in the area.

Termly project

Children can choose one of the following topics for their projects:

- 1. The history of Forest of Dean: How has Forest of Dean changed over time?
- 2. Tourism in Forest of Dean
- 3. Mining in Forest of dean
- 4. Deforestation in Forest of Dean
- 5. Population and housing in Forest of Dean
- 6. Wildlife in Forest of Dean

Children can choose from one of the following formats to present their learning:

- Write a non-chronological report.
- A powerpoint presentation. Children should avoid putting too much writing on the slides –
 instead they should use bullet points, pictures and prompts on the slides to expand on each
 bullet point in their own words.
- A 3D model with a detailed written explanation of the chosen aspect.
- A poster/ a minibook /a leaflet.
