
We will also be promoting Speaking and Listening skills, new vocabulary and introducing phonic sounds for Reading.

In Literacy, we will be linking our reading to our topic, using the following books for story comprehension and discussion.





Maths is taught using the White Rose Maths scheme and this term we will be-

Representing and sorting 9 and 10.

Ordering numerals to 10 forwards and backwards.

We will be learning our number bonds to 10, representing numbers on tens frames and in part, part whole models.

We will also have a week on learning shapes including naming and recognising the properties of 3d shapes, making patterns and repeating patterns.

Here are some of the texts we will be using in our learning:







We will also continue to have fun on the bikes, scooters and large wheeled toys. Please bring a helmet from home if you would like your child to wear one.






We will be celebrating World Book Day on Friday 8th March. The children have been invited to
